Tasting notes

Bright lemon yellow colour. A fresh and sweet fragrance of various fruits such as ripe apple, white peach, grapefruit and pineapple spreads. The attack is smooth and the acidity is refreshing. There is a sense of the volume of the wine. It has a long aftertaste of citrus fruits such as grapefruit and lemon. A medium bodied wine to drink now or later.

Valle Frio Estate, Talca

The VALLEFRIO estate is a family owned and managed estate. It belongs to the family since the beginning of the 19th century and is associated with the family's Holding company; one of Chile's largest agricultural business groups. Its 300 hectares of vineyards are located in the Maule Valley, which is Chile's original vine growing region. The region's viticultural history dates back to the time of colonization by the Spanish in the middle of the 16th century. The estate's vineyards are located in 5 different locations each of which has different soil formations; for each the best suited grape varieties were chosen.

Maule is Chile's largest vine growing area (in the Central Valley) but, being located more southern than many other vine growing regions it has the advantage of a cooler climate and more rainfall during the winter. The nights during the growing season are cooler too. This extends the growing season but results in an excellent balance of ripeness and acidity in the grapes which, in turn, permits the wines to age well.
