Tasting notes

The colour is bright yellow. Fruit aromas of ripe apple, peach and pear mixed with a slight peppery flavour are apparent. The attack is smooth while the texture is soft throughout. The acidity is fresh but not aggressive. The wine is well rounded and has a slight mineral taste and a lasting after-taste. It drinks well now but will last.

The Weingut (estate) Peter Schweiger is run by Peter Schweiger senior and his son Peter (junior). The estate is comprised of 18 Hectares in one of Austria's most reputed areas the Kamptal (Kamp valley). The area offers perfect conditions to grow Austria's famous Grüner Veltliner white wines.

The family also produces a Grüner Veltliner from Niederösterreich an area which is located around Vienna, Austria's capital. Father and son grow their vines in environmentally friendly and sustainable manners. The Grüner from Niederösterreich is a particularly food friendly wine and the Schweiger family is reputed to create excellent dry, fresh, subtly spicy and delicately fruity editions of this popular white wine.
